

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE 2017 FACULTY LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA FACULTY LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

In March 1982, President Zumberge instituted an annual Academic Honors Convocation. As part of this convocation, the university now honors up to four of its retired faculty each year for their eminent careers. One hundred and twenty-five distinguished retired faculty members from across the disciplines have been honored with this prestigious award. Please see page four for a complete list of honorees.

THE AWARD

The Faculty Lifetime Achievement Award includes an honorarium of \$2,000, an illuminated scroll setting forth the honoree's contributions and a citation in the annual Academic Honors Convocation program.

ELIGIBILITY

Retired faculty who have been full-time members of the USC faculty for a minimum of 10 years prior to retirement and are officially retired are eligible for nomination.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Active and retired faculty, administrators and staff, and friends of the university are urged to make nominations.

A letter of nomination should contain a complete description of the nominee's accomplishments and be accompanied by a complete curriculum vitae. It is especially helpful for nominators to comment on specific examples of major contributions.

The nomination form should contain a **brief one-paragraph summary of accomplishments**. In addition to the **nomination letter**, please include **at least two additional letters of endorsement** from individuals who have knowledge of the candidate's contributions. Endorsements from the current dean and department chair (if applicable) of the nominee's academic unit should be among the letters of recommendation. (Note: a current dean or department chair may be the nominator.) Additional letters may be submitted up to a total of five. Letters from both USC colleagues and professional colleagues at other universities are very helpful to the committee. *A letter of endorsement from a professional colleague outside USC describing contributions to the faculty member's field of study will make the nominee more competitive.*

Initial nominations will be considered for a period of three years from the first nomination year.

FACTORS CONSIDERED FOR AWARDS

Awards are made to outstanding faculty on the basis of “**their notable contributions to the university, their profession and community.**” The selection of honorees is made by the Provost after recommendation by the Faculty Lifetime Achievement Award Committee, which is appointed by the Provost. The committee will give consideration to the following areas:

1. Teaching
2. Research
3. Publications
4. University service
5. Community/government service
6. Contributions to professional organizations
7. Professional awards and recognition

DEADLINE FOR NOMINATIONS

Nominations for awards to be presented at the 2017 Academic Honors Convocation must be received by the Faculty Lifetime Achievement Award Committee by 5pm on Friday, November 11th, 2016. Late nominations will be considered the following year.
