USCA ENDOWMENT IN LIFE LONG LEARNING

A fund to assist retired faculty with expenses related to research, publication and lifelong learning projects. Originally supported by the Kenneth T. and Eileen L. Norris Foundation, and now funded through an endowment from the Office of the Provost. One grant of up to \$2,000, or two or three grants totaling \$2,000, may be awarded during the academic year. Previous recipients may reapply for funds after a period of three years.

Grants Conditions:

- Maximum grant is \$2,000 per applicant.
- Funds are used to reimburse research expenses that are not to be reported as income.
- You may not pay for personnel assistance from this fund except to a USC undergraduate or graduate student research assistant who is hired through the Emeriti Center.
- Reprints of any type of publication resulting from this award should acknowledge
 the partial support of the Office of the Provost and the USC Emeriti College, and
 one copy should be forwarded to the College.
