


- Protecting your identity

- Cyber criminals love finding sensitive data such as credit card numbers, social security numbers, addresses, etc!






Click on the upside down triangle on the top right of the screen



Select "Settings"




Click on"Privacy"




Select "Edit" on any of the options

WEAK PASSWORD


- NO PASSWORD AT ALL.
- CONTAINS YOUR USER NAME, REAL NAME, OR COMPANY NAME.
- · PASSWORDS THAT INCREMENT (PASSWORD1, PASSWORD2, PASSWORD3 ...) ARE NOT STRONG.
- CONTAINS A COMPLETE DICTIONARY WORD.
 FOR EXAMPLE, PASSWORD IS A WEAK PASSWORD.

STRONG PASSWORD


- AT LEAST SEVEN CHARACTERS LONG.
- DOES NOT CONTAIN YOUR USER NAME, REAL NAME, OR COMPANY NAME.
 - IS SIGNIFICANTLY DIFFERENT FROM PREVIOUS PASSWORDS
- CONTAINS CHARACTERS FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING UPPER-CASE LETTERS, LOWER-CASE LETTERS, NUMERALS.
