MEMBERSHIP

SRA's membership is open to all retired (identified to the Emeriti Center by the University as being retired) and active USC staff upon completion of their application and payment of Annual or Life dues.

Partners of living or deceased SRA members may also become active members upon payment of Annual or Life dues.


Single Membership:

Open to any USC staff, active or retired, and to the partner of a USC Staff member, active, retired, or deceased. See enclosed Membership Application Form.

Life Membership:

Open to any member for a one-time payment. This membership is non-transferable.

Dues are paid annually. Membership year is July 1 through June 30 of the following year. Members who join between March 1 and June 30 will not be required to pay additional dues for the following year.



ORGANIZATION

The governing body of the SRA is a board of 4 elected officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer) plus chairpersons of standing committees and at least 4 members at large.

The Board meets monthly except when there are major all-member meetings in Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter. Board Meeting dates are posted on the SRA website and are open to all active SRA members.

The SRA serves as an advocate for USC retiree benefits, along with the Retired Faculty Association (RFA) and the Emeriti Center. Together, these groups are represented on the Emeriti Center Benefits and Resource Committee, which cooperates with the USC Administration and Staff Assembly.

The SRA offers social, educational, and entertaining programs to bring our members together and reinforce their lifelong bonds with USC.

Each year, the SRA plans a Staff Recognition Award Luncheon to honor staff members who have retired the previous year.

A retired staff who has contributed outstanding service to the University is nominated for and awarded the J. Tillman-Hall Award.

SRA volunteers send greeting cards to recognize birthdays and anniversaries and to contact members who are ill or have suffered a loss in their family.

Hosts (in collaboration with RFA and the Emeriti Center) the annual Holiday Party in December.

The SRA offers information on topics of interest to retirees, including health, financial and legal issues. aging, special interests, and continuing education. The SRA contributes to the **Emeriti Center to support** activities of importance to the USC Retiree Community. The SRA participates in the Transitions Program designed to help Staff considering retirement. The SRA plans field trips for members as well as musical and theatrical events performed by USC students and guest artists.
